

COVID-19 – Safety Measures Updated

We appreciate your continued support to ensure a safe environment so we can remain accessible and serve our industry.

As we shift into Step 3 of BC's restart plan, we will continue to follow all provincial guidelines with the following safeguards in place to help prevent the spread of communicable disease.

- Complete an online **Health Check Questionnaire** prior to arriving (*an email and text with the link will be sent the day before your course*).
- Mask wearing is recommended in indoor public spaces for all people 12 and older who are not yet fully vaccinated. Currently, we are asking students to please wear a mask when entering our Training Centre. Students may remove their masks when seated in the classroom or as directed by the instructor.
- Registered students only are asked to arrive *no earlier* than 15 minutes before start of class.
- Limiting the number of people in the classroom and the building.
- Physical distancing of two metres is maintained throughout the building.
- Provide hand sanitizing stations throughout the building.
- Increased frequency of cleaning and sanitizing, including classroom and practical equipment.
- Lunchroom area is limited. When leaving the classroom for breaks and lunch, masks and social distancing are recommended.
